

	I have done with the allotment that I rent.	
	When I first rented my allotment the land had not been used well, and the	
	soil was not productive. I have slowly created an organic garden in which to	
	grow fruit and vegetables, and where local wildlife can live. My soil now has worms, centipedes and beetles and there are many animals, birds, and	
	other creatures, I that I and other allotment gardeners have seen. Here is a	
	list of some of the creatures:

	Bats, foxes, kingfishers, slow worms, solitary bees (I have a bee house and drinking station), hedgehogs, butterflies, frogs, newts, toads (a neighbouring allotment has a pond), squirrels and many birds, including buzzards, peregrine falcons, robbins, greenfinches, bullfinches, wrens, blackbirds, and longtailed tits. I am delighted to hear that this precious haven for both food production and wildlife will be protected for us all and future generations.
